

Debtor Deductible Ineligible Calculations


The deductible ineligible reason code allows to determine the ineligible of the debtors with the foreign accounts.


Debtor Eligible Balance < Deductible Value

If the Debtor eligible balance is less than the defined Deductible value, then Deductible ineligible amount is considered as Debtor eligible balance.


For example, Consider Debtor Deductible Amount is set to 7,000.00 under <u>Debtors</u> page and Debtor eligible balance= 6,250.00, then Deductible ineligible amount is considered as Debtor eligible balance, i.e. Debtor eligible balance = 6,250.00.






Debtor Eligible Balance > Deductible Value


If the Debtor eligible balance is greater than the defined Deductible value, then Deductible ineligible value is 0. For example, Consider Debtor Deductible Amount is set to 5,000.00 under <u>Debtors</u> page and Debtor eligible balance = 6,250.00, then Deductible ineligible amount is zero.








Debtor Eligible Balance = Deductible Value

If the Debtor eligible balance is equal to defined Deductible value, then Deductible ineligible value is 0. For example, Consider Debtor Deductible Amount is set to 6250 under <u>Debtors</u> page and Debtor balance = 6,250.00, then Deductible ineligible amount is zero.
